Brazos Valley Off-Road Ranch (BVORR) is approximately 300 acres located in Bryan/College Station, Texas. The site was formally owned and mined for gravel by Gifford Hill Corporation in the 1960's into the 1970's. Back then the regulatory agencies did not require land reclamation. The land has many pits and large hills (Bad Lands). In 1994, Steve Opersteny the current land owner began to work on purchasing the property from the company that bought out Gifford Hill as well as adjacent land owners with a vision that the former gravel pits or bad lands could be put to use as a off-road facility.
